Mayor Heninger reported that the Town had applied for additional funding from Rural Development for the Farmer's Market Structure in the amount of \$33,370. The Town has been awarded additional funding from Rural Development in the amount of \$34,000.

John Clark, Town Manager, reported the East Lee Sidewalk project is completed and discussions are occurring with the Virginia Department of Transportation to extend the sidewalk project to the Downtown area tying in the Downtown Revitalization and the Farmer's Market. A representative from the Virginia Department of Transportation stated the Town has an excellent chance of obtaining funding for the sidewalk extension during the fiscal year 2021. The funding will require a 20% match by the Town.
